Message to Parents:

The mission of Boys and Girls Clubs of Southern Utah is to inspire and enable all young people, especially those who need us most, to realize their full potential as productive, caring, and responsible citizens and leaders.

Through clubs and activities, we hope to expand and grow children's interests, hobbies, life skills, and character. We support and encourage all students to participate and have fun!

Culture Club - Ms. Melissa - K/2 Wednesday & Friday, 3/5 Thursday & Friday

Culture club will be a fun way for students to learn about different cultures around the world through exploring each cultures language, traditional clothing/fashion, food, and cultural & holiday celebrations. February will focus on the culture of Mexico.

- Week #1: Students will engage with the Mexican culture through activities that teach simple phrases and salutations in the Spanish language
- Week #2: Students will learn about the traditional dress of different regions in Mexico. Children will create a paper doll and dress it in the appropriate traditional style from the region of their choice.
- Week #3: Students will learn about a few traditional Mexican cultural and holiday celebrations. Children will create holiday celebration crafts
- Week #4: Students will be trying and making traditional foods from Mexico. (Horchata & Tamales)

Animal Club - Ms. Siena (K/2 specific) - Wednesday & Friday

Each week, students will learn about an animal from a different part of the animal kingdom. Students will get to make a fun craft related to their animal, as well as participate in educational activities.

- Week #1: Students will learn about tigers. They will explore what their habitats look like, what they eat, and other fun facts about tigers. Students will create a tiger mask.
- Week #2: Students will learn about blue whales. They will explore what their habitats look like, what they eat, and other fun facts about blue whales. Students will construct a blue whale out of construction paper.
- Week #3: Students will learn about kangaroos. They will explore what their habitats look like, what they eat, and other fun facts about blue whales. Students will get to create a kangaroo craft with construction paper & popsicle sticks.
- Week #4: Students will learn about iguanas. They will explore what their habitats look like, what they eat, and other fun facts about iguanas. Students will get to create their own life size iguana from craft materials.

Knitting Club - Ms. Siena (3/5 specific) - Thursday & Friday

Students will spend the month working together as a class learning to knit their own hats using their choice of yarn and a hat loom.

- Week #1: Students will be introduced to the knitting methods we will be using, and will start working on the early stages of knitting their hats.
- Week #2: Students will continue working on the beginning stages of their hats with as much instruction and guidance as needed.
- Week #3: Students will work as independently as possible on the middle-end stages of their hats.
- Week #4: Students will finish their hats and get to take their new hand-made fashion accessory home
