- Week 1- learning clay terms and the history of clay. Practicing techniques like coiling, scoring, making shapes and planning projects.

- Week 3- students will paint and then glaze the pinch pots. And will be able to take them home!
- Week 4- Free choice project of either a pinch pot bank or a coil pot!

Animal/Craft Club - Ms. Sienna 3/5 Wednesday & Friday , K/2 Thursday and Friday

Each week, students will learn about an animal from a different part of the animal kingdom. Students will get to make a fun craft related to their animal, as well as participate in educational activities.
