June Club & Activity Details

Hello Parents! We are excited to welcome you to the Boys & Girls Club summer program at Gateway. We will be doing lots of fun STEM, Academic, SEL and Arts & Crafts activities throughout the month. These will be driven by weekly themes that inform and structure the daily activities. These are listed on the calendar above and detailed below. Teachers and kids will be fighting the summer 'brain drain' with our Project Learn classes and Americorps math and reading tutors. Kids will also have the opportunity to choose from clubs that give opportunities to learn new skills. A description of what clubs we are offering, and what kids will be learning on a weekly basis is detailed below.

Weekly Theme for June 11-June 14:

Bugs, Bees & Butterflies: Summer is here! And so are all the cute, strange, and magical creatures in the insect world. Our STEM labs this week will focus on the importance of pollinators and insects to the health of our environment; Kids will be making alien bug crafts and colorful butterflies during Arts & Crafts time; Bug math and so many books about bugs, bees & insects will be the focus in Project Learn and summer reading classes.

Weekly Theme for June 18-June 21:

On the Farm: Fur & Feathers: Kids will explore the importance of farms to our community, country and world, while also meeting all the furry and feathered friends that live and work on farms. Our STEM labs this week will focus on creating growing environments for plants and animals (Oh look! Our pollinators friends are here, too!). Kids will be creating puppets of their favorite furry or feathered farm animals. Farm math will rule the week, and kids will be writing and preparing their own puppet show as part of summer reading time.

Weekly Theme for June 25-28:

Frog & Toad: Kids will be exposed to the incredible variety of amphibians that exist not only in Utah, but on nearly every continent of the world. Our STEM labs this week will focus on the vital role amphibians play in keeping ecosystems healthy, and their amazing (super hero!) physical attributes. Frog origami and stuffed axolotls will rule Arts & Crafts activities, while our literary friends, Frog & Toad, will make an appearance during summer reading time and in our SEL review/lesson Thoughts, Feelings & Actions.
