### **Social Emotional Learning:**

**KidGrit** - The kid-grit collective is passionate about equipping educators and students with the tools needed for success. Our innovative, mindful approach builds confidence & character, resilience & social-emotional learning, self-care & wellness.

### **Academic Support:**

**Power Hour** - The main focus of power hour will be to help youth complete homework assignments, work on HYLEA activities and also participate in our reading program. Our goal is to help youth reduce missing assignments. If you know what homework your student should be working on, please let us know and we will do our best to ensure they get it done! Because it's the end of the school year, after students have completed their assignments, they will be able to choose a tech based activity to participate in during Power Hour. ### **STEM Labs:**
