July Club & Activity Details

Message to Parents:

We are excited to welcome you to the Walden Elementary Boys & Girls Club summer program. We will be doing lots of fun STEM, Academic and SEL activities throughout the month. These will be driven by weekly themes that inform and structure the daily activities. These are listed on the calendar above and detailed below. Teachers and youth will be fighting the summer 'brain drain' with read-aloud book discussion. A description of what clubs we are offering, and what kids will be learning on a weekly basis is detailed below.

Social Emotional Learning: Social Emotional Learning curriculum is an evidence based program that is integrated in afterschool activities to build a positive environment throughout the program – an environment that encourages students to do their best and be their best. Positive Action teaches real-life concepts that help students feel good about themselves. Each weekly theme corresponds to a twice a week lesson where youth will engage in positive actions and attitudes as they learn about themselves and others.

Literacy: Preventing summer "brain drain" is an important first step in ensuring a successful new school year. We are excited to focus our literacy time in a read-aloud of *The Secret Garden*. This beloved story of the garden, the key, and the robin is broken down into easy, twenty-minute chunks—perfect for daily read-alouds. Thoughtful questions after each passage boost comprehension and facilitate meaningful discussion. Youth will learn vocabulary, strengthen literacy, and bond over beautiful literature.

STEM: Daily STEM lessons engage youth with hands-on learning activities designed to challenge problem-solving skills, develop critical thinking, and build an understanding of the world around them. This month we will examine experimental design and delve into the engineering behind creating a book. Each child will have the opportunity to participate in designing and carrying out their own experiment as well as creating a book from cover to cover.

Clubs

Olympics - Let's get our bodies moving! This month's club will invigorate your body as we prepare for our very own Walden Olympics! Each day we will participate in preparatory Sports for our very own Walden Olympics. We will also learn about different countries and cultures that are participating in this summer Olympics.

Literacy Explorers - There is a whole world of adventure waiting to be found through books, comics, prose and illustrations. Each day this week, we will learn about different aspects of literacy through hands-on and engaging activities. From learning new words in prominent world languages to illustrating a panel of comics, we will explore how literacy can enhance learning and fun.
