

Message to Parents:

Starting club to build a community in our Boys & Girls Club. The goal of our club is to build trust with youth and team members. As well as learn the interest of our members. Making our space safe and fun for different kinds of learning for team and members.

Community Builder Club - Playing games for staff and members to get to know each other. Playing the name game in a circle inside or outside. Other ice break games. And cleaning the large mats outside in teams of two.

Skits Club - Acting out skits for social emotional learning [Leader In Me!] and learning performing skills in front of an audience of members. Learning the movements of the 7 Habits. And learning how to speak in front of other people, a important part of life skills.

STEM Club - Doing a variety of fun experiments, learning new skills of following directions and being patient during the science process. Members get to do hands in these activities. Watch for success or failure in the process.
