Message to Parents:

We are super excited to have your kids here with us at the Boys and Girls Club this school year! The month of September will consist of bracelet making, cardboard creations, pokemon competitions, watercoloring, solar oven smores, and personality traits self portraits! We cannot wait to tune our minds, better learn to take care of ourselves, and grow together as a program! We aim to teach respect, kindness, and self confidence.

BRACELET CREATIONS- We will be offering a club that will teach kids different knots and braids in the form of bracelet making! This will be held Monday and Wednesday 4:45-5:15 PM during our first week!

CARDBOARD CREATIONS - Our cardboard creation club hopes to teach the kids how to use their imagination to create things out of cardboard! This will be held Monday and Wednesday from 4:45-5:15 PM.

POKEMON - Our pokemon club will teach the kids how to make their own pokemon character cards, how to play, and how to compete! We hope this inspires creativity and helps them play well with others. This will be held from 4:45-5:15 PM on Tuesdays.

PERSONALITY TRAITS SELF PORTRAITS - This club will be offered on Wednesdays from 4:45-5:15 PM. The kids will learn different personality traits that they may have and will create a self portrait with artistic presentation of each trait.

POTTERY: Using air dry clay, a staff will be teaching the student how to create pottery dishes! This will be held from 4:45-5:15 PM on Wednesdays!

WATERCOLORING - Our watercoloring club will be held on Thursdays from 4:45-5:15 PM and will be teaching the students the basics of watercolor painting techniques.

STEM CLUB - Our STEM specialist will be helping our students conduct scientific experiments. This month we will be learning about solar energy and heat and ending it with making solar oven smores! These activities will be offered on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 4:45-5:15 PM.

SMART CLUB - Our SMART club focuses on helping students become more emotionally intelligent and socially adept.

FUN FRIDAY ROTATIONS: After a busy week, we love to have a day of fun activities! Fun Friday gives the students the option to choose between our crafts, gym time, outside recess, games, drawings, and sometimes a special electronic game! This is held from 4:00-5:15 PM on Fridays!
