Future Builders: Career and College Life Skills - Prepare for the future while having fun in Future Builders Club, a Friday after school program designed to introduce students ages 5-12 to the exciting world of careers and essential life skills. Through engaging, hands-on activities, students will explore their interests, develop important skills, and learn about the many possibilities that await them in the future. **Future Builders Club** is a dynamic and age-appropriate way to introduce young learners to the idea of building a bright future.
