We are so excited to be implementing these programs and clubs to help your kids! If you have any questions or any ideas for what you would like your child to be learning while here at the club please feel free to let us know. Thanks!

Student Leadership club - Our student leadership club centers on the older kids leading activities with the younger kids or having leadership centered activities that the younger students can lead and participate in in order to help develop those skills for future use!

Sportsmanship development club - This is in replacement of our SMART moves that we would do on Fridays. It is an opportunity for the students to be able to engage in competitive, safe and enriching activities that focus on cooperation and team building.

Magic the Club - With as much love as the kids showed to our DND clubs we are keeping the theme with Magic the club! In this club the kids are learning about the famous game Magic the Gathering and putting their own spin on it with the skills they earned playing D&D last month! We will be developing our imaginations, our problem solving skills, our critical thinking and more!

Anatomy Club - The body is such a unique and amazing machine that we each have access to every minute of our lives, and so much of it flies under the radar! In Anatomy club we will learn about the cool secret facts about all of our bodies, the things they do in the background, the intricate incredible details that we all have within our DNA and games and activities to show us all of it!

Project Learn - Project Learn or "Power Hour" is our academic time Monday - Thursday to help support what our club members are learning during the school day. Boys & Girls Club offers homework help, High Yield Learning activities, and other fun games/activities that have an academic focus that are still fun!

STEM - STEM is our twice a week rotation that is taught by our AmeriCorps members! STEM includes topics of science, technology, engineering, and math. Social Emotional Learning- Similar to previous years, Boys & Girls Club uses two social emotional learning curricula- SMART Moves and Positive Action. Within both curriculums, club members will learn a lot about feelings, emotions, being a good friend/peer, and ways to help others. Social Emotions are crucial to development and we make learning fun through these curriculums!



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
