We are so excited to announce our winter semester of After School Clubs at Provost Elementary! We look forward to continuing to build relationships with our club members, teach them new skills that can help them in the future, and watch them grow into future leaders!

Clubs will run Monday-Thursday from 3:15 - 5:15 pm. There will be no clubs on Fridays this year.

#### REGISTRATION INFORMATION

<u>Pre-registration</u> is now open! By completing this form early, you can save time on the day of club sign ups and submit your Club Choice Form faster, giving your student a better chance at their top club picks.

**Important:** Pre-registration does not sign your child up for specific clubs. On Monday, January 13th, you must fill out the **Club Choice Form** to select your student's preferred clubs.

On January 13th, you'll receive an email around 7:00 AM with a link to the Club Choice Form. This form will ask you to rank your student's top four club choices (1st through 4th). Club placement is based on the order forms are submitted. If your student's 1st choice is full, we'll place them in their next available choice, and so on, based on availability.

Please Note: You won't receive a confirmation email right away. Once all submissions are reviewed and students are placed, we'll send confirmation emails with your student's club assignment. Please be patient during this process. Your student's registration is **not complete** until you receive a confirmation email stating they have been placed in a club.

Due to the high demand of clubs, your student will only be registered for **ONE club** during sign ups. On the Club Choice Form, there will be a question asking if you'd like your student to be considered for a second club. If you select "yes," and there is space available after registration ends, your student will automatically be placed in an additional club based on their 1st-4th choice rankings. We will notify you by email or phone if this happens.

If your student signs up for a club and misses that club more than twice in a row, without a parent letting us know that they will be gone that day, we will replace them with another student. If they are sick or you let us know via email they will be gone that day, their space will be saved. That way we don't waste the space on students who end up not wanting to be in clubs.

# **NEWER PROGRAM COMPONENT**

Helping our Club Members develop essential skills in managing emotions, building relationships, and developing resiliency are key parts of our social-emotional learning program. Club Members participate in 30 minute sessions where they learn about different management strategies, understanding feelings for themselves and others, and so much more. **Positive Action** is the evidence based curriculum we integrate throughout afterschool activities to build a positive environment throughout the program – an environment that encourages our Club Members to do their best and be their best. This program is run daily with new topics each week. Our afterschool program is available to your family because we provide this grant-funded component.

#### PICKUP INFORMATION

With the new year, also comes some new staff. With this we will need all parents to bring ID for pick up and ensure you add anyone who is able to pick up the child to their registration. We do this to ensure the safety of all Club Members and their families.
