Message to Parent

We are so excited for the fun activities we have planned for March! We look forward to continuing to build relationships with the youth, teach them new skills that can help them in the future, and watch them grow into future leaders!

Our Core Promise

To America's youth we promise to provide a safe, positive place and to have a significant impact on their lives. Social Emotional Learning:

Leader In Me- Social Emotional Learning Curriculum is an evidence based program that is integrated in afterschool activities to build a positive environment throughout the program – an environment that encourages students to do their best and be their best. This program is run Monday through Thursday

Academic Support:

Power Hour: The main focus of power hour will be to help youth complete homework assignments, wor on HYLA activities and their book in a bag. Our goal is to help youth reduce missing assignments by aligning with school teachers, and working on daily assignments at programs to allow family time at home. If you know what homework your student should be working on, please let us know and we will do our best to assist them! We do power hour Monday-Thursday.

STEM Club- Provide hands-on learning experiences in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics. Students engage in projects like building simple circuits, constructing bridges, coding with beginner-friendly software, and conducting science experiments. These activities are designed to be interactive and fun, helping kids develop problem-solving skills, creativity, and a strong foundation in STEM concepts while encouraging teamwork and curiosity about the world around them.

Around the World- Embark on a thrilling adventure where kids discover the world without leaving their school! Each month, we "visit" a different country, diving into its culture, landmarks, and traditions while learning key words and phrases in its language. Through engaging crafts, interactive games, and hands-on activities, members collect stamps in their "passports" as they explore new ways to communicate and connect with the world. Are you ready to explore? Let's get started!

Puppets- students will explore the art of puppetry through hands-on creativity and storytelling. They will design and create their own puppets, learn performance techniques, and bring their characters to life through fun and engaging skits. The club will encourage self-expression, collaboration, and confidence while making learning playful and interactive.
