Hello Everyone! We are so excited to move into the month of March! This month we will be focusing on being honest about who we are and discovering our truth in all of our lessons and throughout our clubs. Please be sure to note the closure dates in March. Please continue to review our Parent and Student Handbooks with your members as we are still struggling to get back into appropriate routines and behaviors in the club and want the club to be a safe and fun environment for all in attendance. Thank you for your ongoing support.

Project Learn- Project Learn or "Power Hour" is our academic time Monday-Thursday to help support what our club members are learning during the school day. Boys & Girls Club offers homework help, High Yield Learning activities and other fun games/activities that have an academic focus that are still fun! This month we will focus on math and literacy skills through games, activities and buddy reading.

STEM-is our twice a week rotation that is taught by our Americorps members. STEM includes topics of Science, Technology, Engineering and Math. Within this club our members will be able to learn and explore aspects of how the world works around them. Building, creating and constructing projects out of objects in the world around them.

Social Emotional Learning- Social Emotional Learning is crucial to development and helping to build lifelong regulation skills. We make learning fun through these curriculums. The curriculum Boys & Girls club uses is an evidence based program called Positive Action. Through this curriculum and its many lessons, club members will learn how to take care of their bodies and minds.

Get Moving Club-Club members have the opportunity to learn about various sports and games. Members will practice gross motor skills, teamwork and sportsmanship. The Get Moving club is separated by grade group to make sure that all members are safe, as different ages have different understandings, abilities and motives.

Career Exploration Club-Members will have the opportunity to shape the curriculum of this exploration club as they grow and express opinions about their future occupations. Members will be encouraged to take club insights outside of school and guest speakers will be invited.
