### Message to Parent

We are so excited for the fun activities we have planned for April! We look forward to continuing to build relationships with the youth, teach them new skills that can help them in the future, and watch them grow into future leaders!

### Our Core Promise

### Social Emotional Learning:

**Leader In Me-** Social Emotional Learning Curriculum is an evidence based program that is integrated in afterschool activities to build a positive environment throughout the program – an environment that encourages students to do their best and be their best. This program is run Monday through Thursday

### Academic Support:

**Power Hour:** The main focus of power hour will be to help youth complete homework assignments, work on HYLE activities and their book in a bag. Our goal is to help youth reduce missing assignments by aligning with school teachers, and working on daily assignments at programs to allow family time at home. If you know what homework your student should be working on, please let us know and we will do our best to assist them! We do power hour Monday-Thursday.

**Creative Spark Club-** is an after-school program where kids can let their imaginations run wild! Whether it's drawing, building, writing, or making crafts, this club is all about expressing creativity in fun and different ways. Each week, students will try out new projects, work on their ideas, and explore different forms of art. It's a great place to make new friends, share creative ideas, and have fun while being artistic!

**Wind and Weather Club-** is where kids learn about the exciting world of weather! Through hands-on activities, experiments, and fun outdoor observations, kids will become young meteorologists and discover how wind, rain, and sunshine shape our environment. It's a great way to learn about weather and have fun while getting outside!

**STEM Club-** provides hands-on learning experiences in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics. Students engage in projects like building simple circuits, constructing bridges, coding with beginner-friendly software, and conducting science experiments. These activities are designed to be interactive and fun, helping kids develop problem-solving skills, creativity, and a strong foundation in STEM concepts while encouraging teamwork and curiosity about the world around them.

**Water Wonders Club-** students will explore the exciting world of water! Through fun activities and experiments, they'll learn about how water works, the animals that live in it, and how we can take care of our water. It's a hands-on way to discover the magic of water and the environment!
