Message to Parents:

Teachers have lots of fun activities planned to help children learn about the importance of a healthy body and mind, how to set and achieve personal goals, and what happens when we sow seeds of kindness and friendship in our community. Fridays will continue to be a fun day with arts, jewelry making and board game creation, along with fun choice activities. Our students are so creative! We love seeing what they create. Thanks, as always, for sharing your children with us. We love celebrating their achievements with them, and are honored to have the opportunity to watch them grow and learn.

Board Game/Creating Club with Ms. Goodie:

Fridays 4:00-5:00

During this club students will, through play, research the various aspects and attributes of board games. Students will be taking their research on these games and brainstorming ideas for their own game. At the end of this club (in May!) students will have developed and built a game of their own design that they can share with their friends and families

April 4: Research Through Play Day: Students will play more board games and continue to note how the games are played and the rules they have, in preparation for creating their own board game

April 11: Brainstorming different kinds of games that you would like to create. Come up with at least three different types of games you would like to create.

April 25 : Continuing to brainstorm/coming up with rough draft images. Picking one game you really wish to create and then moving to creating basic rules of that game. Making a list of materials that you would need in order to create your game. EX: Glue, paper, markers, dice, cardboard, tape, etc.

Art Club with Miss Halli

Art club! Students will be able to explore and learn about different kinds of art, while learning about the importance of creativity and composition.

April 4: Weaving with Paper: Students will learn more about the possibilities of paper and will learn to create a woven heart!

April 11: Paper Mâché: Students will continue to learn more about the possibilities of paper by learning about paper Mâché and creating their own pinata.

April 25: Art & Community: Students will learn about how art can bring people together by creating their own tic-tac-toe rocks and board!













Jewelry Making Club with Miss Gillian

Fridays 4:00-5:00

Jewelry Making Club focuses on fostering creativity, improving fine motor skills, and building confidence as students design and craft unique pieces of jewelry. Members will explore various materials and techniques, from basic beading to advanced designs, while learning about the cultural and artistic significance of jewelry-making.

April 4: Making Earrings Using Wire-Wrapping and Beads: Students will learn how to create earrings using wire-wrapping techniques and beads. They will practice bending wire, creating loops, and attaching beads to design their own custom earrings, exploring creativity while developing fine motor skills.

April 11: Heart Friendship Bracelets: Students will create heart-patterned friendship bracelets using embroidery floss. They will learn threading, knotting, and pattern-making techniques while focusing on creating a meaningful gift for a friend.

April 25: Spiral and Twisted Designs: Students will explore spiral or twisted designs using embroidery floss. This activity emphasizes the importance of precision and introduces techniques for adding a dynamic, textured look to their bracelets.
