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## May Club & Activity Details

### Message to Parents:

**HAPPY MAY!** It is crazy to think we are in the final month of club and of the school year! We have loved having the opportunity to work with all of your children and to get to know all of you. This year has been full of amazing experiences that us as staff will cherish forever! Our **last day of club is on May 16, 2025**. To celebrate the end of the year we will be having our final family night that day. We will have an awards ceremony to celebrate the kids and to highlight their accomplishments. This will take place on May 16, 4pm-5:30pm. We hope you can join us to celebrate this year!

**Future Builders: Career and College Life Skills** - Prepare for the future while having fun in Future Builders Club, a Friday after school program designed to introduce students ages 5-12 to the exciting world of careers and essential life skills. Through engaging, hands-on activities, students will explore their interests, develop important skills, and learn about the many possibilities that await them in the future. **Future Builders Club** is a dynamic and age-appropriate way to introduce young learners to the idea of building a bright future. By fostering curiosity, confidence, and critical thinking, we aim to inspire every student to dream big and achieve their goals! This will run each Friday we have after school! Our Final lesson will be on May 2 and will be a Job Day where they can practice different jobs with one another!

**Social-Emotional Learning -- Emotion Explorers: Building Your Emotional Toolkit** is a set of lessons built by our Site coordinator. It is a fun and supportive Monday and Wednesday program designed to help students ages 5-12 develop self-efficacy and emotional wellness. Through engaging activities, students will learn to recognize, understand, and manage their emotions while building essential tools for resilience and confidence.

**Power Hour** - The primary focus of Power Hour is to support our youth in completing their homework, engaging in High Yield Learning Activities (HYLAs), and participating in our reading and math programs. Because it is the last few weeks of school, we know some kids do not have homework anymore. For students without homework, we offer a variety of HYLAs, along with our reading and math programs, to further enhance their overall knowledge and skills in these important subjects. We also work with the school to have access to computers so the students can complete iReady or other school related curricula. We will be adapting our Power Hour time to fit the needs of the kids in our final weeks. This is completed Monday-Thursday for 45 minutes!



**Mr. Alex Fun Days** - We're excited to share that **Mr. Alex** will be hosting two special afternoons of safe, active fun inspired by **Field Day** favorites! These events are designed with all ages in mind and focus on teamwork, movement, and smiles—all while keeping safety a top priority. Students will work together in fun, low-impact games like **bean bag toss**, **parachute play**, **cone stacking relays**, and a friendly round of **cup stacking races**. These activities encourage cooperation, balance, and focus—without the rough-and-tumble! Mr. Alex will lead the group through silly and safe challenges like the **crab walk race**, **rainbow ribbon relays**, and **freeze dance games**. There will also be a **balance beam challenge** using floor tape and soft objects—perfect for practicing coordination in a playful way! These two days are all about **inclusion, movement, and fun**, and Mr. Alex's thoughtful planning ensures every student can participate safely. Make sure your child comes ready to move in comfy clothes and closed-toe shoes! Students will participate in his activities on Mondays.

**Ms. Lexie Fun Days** - To wrap up the school year in style, **Ms. Lexie** is planning **two fun-filled afternoons** of creative expression, reflection, and celebration! These special days will give students a chance to look back on their favorite memories, share their creativity, and celebrate the unique individuals they've become this year. Students will dive into reflective crafts like: **"My Year in Review" Collages** – A creative way to capture their favorite moments from afterschool this year using drawings, magazine clippings, and stickers. **Friendship Bracelets** – A sweet way to celebrate the connections they've made. **Chalk Art Messages** – Kids will create kind, colorful chalk messages to decorate our program space for the final days. Ms. Lexie will guide the group through meaningful projects such as: **Decorate Your Own Gratitude Journal** – A simple notebook becomes a space for kids to write or draw what they're thankful for. **Autograph Posters** – Students can sign each other's posters with kind messages and memories. **Mini Party Crowns or Hats** – Each student will design a crown to celebrate their growth this year and wear it for a mini celebration to close out the day! With Ms. Lexie's warm creativity and care, these two days will be a perfect way for students to reflect, express themselves, and celebrate the year they've had together. Students will participate in her activities on Tuesdays.

**Mr. Phoenix Fun Days** - As we wrap up an amazing year, **Mr. Phoenix** is planning two exciting afternoons filled with **STEM exploration, creativity, and hands-on fun**! These special days will give students the chance to celebrate what they've learned while exploring science, technology, engineering, and math through playful challenges and experiments. Students will rotate through a variety of hands-on activities, such as: **Build-a-Bridge Challenge** – Use simple materials to design and test mini bridges. **Balloon Rockets** – Explore basic physics by launching balloons across the room! **Slime Lab** – Mix up a fun, safe batch of end-of-year slime and learn about chemical reactions. **Cup Tower Engineering** – Compete in a timed cup-stacking challenge using strategy and teamwork. Mr. Phoenix will take the learning outdoors (weather permitting) with active STEM games and a final end-of-year challenge: **Math Relay Races** – Solve fun math puzzles at each checkpoint. **Code-a-Path Obstacle Course** – Students "program" their teammates through a human coding maze. **STEM Jeopardy** – Review key STEM topics from the year in a friendly trivia competition. These two days will be a perfect blend of **energy, learning, and fun** as students celebrate their growth and curiosity with Mr. Phoenix's guidance! Students will participate in his activities on Wednesdays.

**Mr. Armando Fun Days** - We're excited to announce that **Mr. Armando** will be hosting **two special days** of fun, high-energy physical activities in our afterschool program! These upcoming afternoons are all about movement, teamwork, and enjoying the outdoors. Students will get to join Mr. Armando for a friendly **soccer game**, where they'll practice their passing, shooting, and team play. After that, we'll switch gears with some fast-paced **frisbee fun**—including games of catch, frisbee tag, and cool trick throws. It's the perfect mix of skill-building and fun! Mr. Armando will lead a variety of classic and new **playground games**—like freeze tag, sharks & minnows, relay races, and more. These activities help students stay active while building teamwork, confidence, and friendships through play. We can't wait for these exciting afternoons! Be sure your child wears comfortable clothes and shoes so they can join in all the action. Thanks to Mr. Armando's energy and creativity, these two days are sure to be a highlight of the week! Students will participate in his activities on Thursdays.

**Ms. Maya Fun Days** - To end the year on a high note, **Mrs. Maya** has planned **two very special afternoons** to celebrate our students in meaningful, joyful ways. From birthdays to big accomplishments, we're taking time to recognize each child and the amazing year we've had together! We're throwing a fun and festive **birthday party** to celebrate all the students who had birthdays during the second half of the school year. There will be games, music, decorations, and a sweet treat to make everyone feel special.
