Jewelry Making Club with Miss Gillian

Jewelry Making Club focuses on fostering creativity, improving fine motor skills, and building confidence as students design and craft unique pieces of jewelry. Members will explore various materials and techniques, from basic beading to advanced designs, while learning about the cultural and artistic significance of jewelry-making.

May 2: Making Earrings Using Wire-Wrapping and Beads: Students will learn how to create earrings using wire-wrapping techniques and beads. They will practice bending wire, creating loops, and attaching beads to design their own custom earrings, exploring creativity while developing fine motor skills.

May 9: Heart Friendship Bracelets: Students will create heart-patterned friendship bracelets using embroidery floss. They will learn threading, knotting, and pattern-making techniques while focusing on creating a meaningful gift for a friend.
