Message to Parents:

Our mission with clubs and activities is to give your child more opportunities for learning and interactive activities with their peers. The goal is to provide an environment that gives your child the opportunity of choice and integrate into new activities each month. There will be a new set of clubs and activities each month that will be posted on the calendar. For monthly clubs, it is the goal to build on each activity weekly, giving your child the opportunity to learn new skills every week! Every day we spend time with students doing power hour for academic support. Your child has time during clubs to work on homework that they have been given during the school day and they receive assistance from all Boys and Girls Club staff. On Tuesdays and Thursdays students are able to participate in a staff-led activity for the purpose of social and emotional learning. This time is allotted for students to become more educated on life skills and emotional intelligence! Creative Club: This is our opportunity to enjoy activities that allow students to show their creative side and understand new hobbies that they might enjoy. Back by popular request, we will be doing another month of Kids Club, where our students get to teach the group something about which they are passionate!

Physical Club: This club is a time where we can vote and agree on a game or physical activity that will be fun for club members. It often leads to basketball games, kickball, four square or tag. This month we will be learning to play volleyball!

Positive Action: This is a Social Emotional Learning curriculum that utilizes actions and activities to identify club members emotions and feelings, and gives them choices to express them appropriately.

Fun Friday: This is a time for club members to challenge one another in games, races, drawing contests, or to spend time engaging in their favorite crafts. Free time helps us become better at choosing what we like.

Summer Program: There are many summer camps available for our kids, but there's no camp quite like the Boys & Girls Clubs Summer Camp! We're excited to share our offerings for this summer—filled with food, fun, and countless opportunities for learning and growth. How can students beat the summer slide? By joining the Boys & Girls Club! Where can they make new friends and



participate in engaging activities? At the Boys & Girls Club! And how can parents be sure their child is safe and happy? The answer is, the Boys & Girls Club!

Our traditional summer camp is packed with exciting activities, including indoor and outdoor games, STEM opportunities, arts and crafts, sports, team building games, and engaging weekly events. We will also take time each day to practice math and literacy skills. Each day is thoughtfully structured, beginning with enriching Summer Brain Gain activities and ending with active play.

- **Program Length:** 6 weeks
- **Locations:** Sandstone, Legacy, Paradise Canyon & Panorama
- **Ages:** 6-12 (Grades K-6)
- **Fee:** \$110 per week/per child
 - \$660 for the 6-week program
 - **+ \$20 annual membership fee**
- **Payment:** Fees must be paid online prior to the start of summer or through an approved payment plan.
- **Financial assistance:** We also want to share that financial assistance is available for families through scholarships provided by our Club partners, The Boys & Girls Clubs of Utah and Wasatch County, and Southern Utah, as well as through child care subsidies.
