Within this club our members will be able to learn and explore aspects of how the world works around them. Building, creating, and constructing projects out of objects in the world around them.

Social Emotional Learning - Similar to previous years, Boys & Girls Club uses two social emotional learning curriculums— SMART Moves and Positive Action. Within both curriculums, club members will learn a lot about feelings, emotions, being a good friend/peer, and ways to help others.
