# June Club & Activity Details

### **Message to Parents:**

Welcome to the Provo Clubhouse Summer Program with Boys and Girls Club. We are so excited for all the activities and clubs that we have planned for this summer and hope that our club members will have a summer to remember!

The club members will be separated into different age groups that they will be with all summer with opportunities to have some fun with the kids in other groups at recess, lunch, and other activities throughout the summer.

Every week each age group will participate in STEM, Literacy Enrichment, Social Emotional Lessons, and even some Math refreshers to keep those skills sharp over the summer. Our club members will also get to participate in a variety of clubs and activities in the morning and the afternoon, as shown below in the club descriptions, rotating through a different club each day.

### **Social Emotional Learning:**

<u>Positive Action</u> - Social Emotional Learning curriculum is an evidence based program that is integrated in afterschool activities to build a positive environment through the program – an environment that encourages students to do their best and be their best. Positive Action teaches real-life concepts that help students feel good about themselves.

### **Academic Support:**

**HYLA**- or high-yield learning activities that include leisure reading, writing activities and games that encourage club members to use their brain and develop cognitive skills. A high-yield learning activity is one in which youth use skills, information, behavior and values needed for academic success.

**STEM**- stands for Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics. STEM based activities promote critical thinking, curiosity, decision making, and leadership skills.

<u>Provo Library Partnership</u>- We have also been able to create a new partnership with the Provo Library where they will come in and do additional HYLA and STEM activities with the kids on Tuesdays - working with a different age group each week.


#### **Guest Speakers/Field Trips:**

Makenna Durfey w/ Painting Love - Local artist, Makenna Durfey, is so excited to come and work with the kids twice this month teaching painting classes by age and based on our weekly theme. On June 9th, the older kids (3rd-6th) will rotate through and paint with a theme of "Outer Space Explorers" and on June 23rd, the younger kids (K-2nd) will rotate through and paint with a theme of "Under the Sea"

<u>Bank of America</u>- will be bringing in some volunteers to come and teach their "Better Money Habits" for our older kids class and doing a little activity with them as well to keep them engaged and learning!

<u>Timpanogos Elementary Playground</u> - Because we don't have a playground at Dixon Middle School, we are opting to walk the 2 blocks to Timpanogos with the kids each day. We currently have it scheduled out during the outdoor recess/PE time in the mornings with K-3 going to the park M/W/F and 4th-6th going T/TH/F. Permission slips will need to be filled out for our club members to be able to participate. PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU PUT SUNSCREEN ON YOUR KIDS BEFORE DROPPING THEM OFF AT SUMMER PROGRAM.









#### **Enrichment Clubs:**

<u>Outdoor & Adventure Club</u> - AM Club. This club is all about getting our kids out and exploring the world around them. Club members will go on different adventures such as going on a space mission, going on scavenger hunts, completing obstacle courses, and so much more!

<u>Music Appreciation</u> - AM Club. Club members will have the opportunity to listen to and create music together. Not only will our club members get to enjoy music, but they will also learn how to work as a team, practice basic counting skills with different rhythms, and most importantly - have fun!

<u>Around the World</u> - AM Club. This club will take our club members "around the world" doing different activities each week that line up with our weekly theme. Kids will get to learn about the different places around the world as they participate in fun and engaging activities.

**Zen Club** - AM Club. We all need a little more mindfulness and Zen in our lives and this club is the one to help us achieve that peace and calm. Club members will participate in activities ranging from yoga to building a zen garden.

<u>Animal Club</u> - AM Club. Club members will get to learn about different animals all around the world and even make some of their own creations inspired by animals.

<u>Photography Club</u> - AM Club. Club members will have the opportunity to work on their photography skills by using actual cameras and building upon their creative skills.

<u>Art Club</u> - PM Club. We are so excited to have an art club that will allow the kids experiences to use different mediums and also give them opportunities to get their creative juices flowing.

<u>Upcycling & More</u> - PM Club. Club members will definitely be getting their creative juices flowing with upcycling what seems like unusable items into a treasure. If you have clean empty toilet paper rolls, feel free to donate them to this club, they will be put to great use!
