Message to Parents:

We are so excited to welcome you and your student(s) to the program this year! Our team is looking forward to an amazing year filled with learning, fun, and new experiences. We're especially excited to kick things off with our enrichment clubs, where students will have the chance to explore new interests, build friendships, and create lasting memories. Thank you for allowing us to be a part of your child's journey—we can't wait to get started!

Club 101 - is an introduction to our club rules and expectations. During this time, students learn what it means to be part of the club community and how we can all work together to make it a safe, fun, and respectful place for everyone. This helps set the tone for the year and ensures that all members understand what is expected of them while also feeling welcomed and included.

Season of Fun - Every Tuesday and Thursday, kids will explore their creativity with exciting seasonal projects. Each season brings a new theme—like pumpkins in the fall, snowmen in the winter, and flowers in the spring.

Kindness is Free - This program helps youth understand, practice, and share kindness in their daily lives—at school, in clubs, and in the community. Through essential social and emotional skills, students build positive relationships, prevent bullying, and create a foundation for a compassionate, respectful future.

Clay Club - Squish it, roll it, and shape it your way! In Clay Club, we'll get a little messy while learning new tricks each week. From silly shapes to awesome creations, you'll build your skills and make something cool to take home!

Bowling Club - Strike up some fun On Monday and Wednesdays! In this club, kids will learn and practice new bowling skills, building on what they've learned each session. From technique to teamwork, every week brings more confidence and improvement on the lanes.

The Belonging Club - The Belonging Club is a fun and welcoming space where students get the chance to know one another, make new friends, and feel part of a supportive community. This will be held every Monday. Through games, activities, and conversations, students practice kindness, teamwork, and respect while learning how to celebrate each other's differences. Our goal is to help every child feel included, valued, and confident that they belong.

Creative Choice Club - Creative Choice Club gives students the chance to take a break and choose activities that interest them most. Whether they want to read, play games, draw, or simply relax, this club allows members to enjoy a little freedom in how they spend their time while still being in a safe and supportive environment. Choice Time helps students recharge, explore their interests, and build independence through self-directed play. The club will be held every Monday and Wednesday.

Digital Citizenship (Friday, September 5th) - All students who use computers during the afterschool program are required to complete the Digital Citizenship lessons once, as this is a Boys & Girls Clubs of America requirement. Each lesson is about 15 minutes long and helps guide students through important internet safety practices. While using computers, all club members will be closely monitored and will only have access to school-approved websites.





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
