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September Club & Activity Details

Message to Parents:

Happy September! We are excited to enjoy our first full month of program together. This month we will be adding lots of new students to our group and will be having fun experiences each day. Below will outline some of the activities we will be doing each week. Feel free to reach out if you ever have any questions, comments, or concerns about what we do in Boys & Girls Club each day!

STEM: Stands for Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics. STEM based activities promote critical thinking, curiosity, decision making, and leadership skills. During STEM, our students will engage in hands-on activities that allow them to explore the world around them and practice using their critical thinking skills. STEM activities will occur Mondays and Wednesdays from 4:15-4:45 PM.

Social Emotional Learning: Social Emotional Learning curriculum is an evidence based program that is integrated in afterschool activities to build a positive environment throughout the program -- an environment that encourages students to do their best and be their best. We will have two different curriculums throughout the year: Positive Action and SMART Moves. Positive Action teaches real-life concepts that help students feel good about themselves. SMART moves helps students create a positive environment in their classroom through collaboration, student leadership, hands on games and activities and team building. Social Emotional Learning will occur on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 4:15-4:45 PM (Positive Action) and Fridays (SMART Moves) from 4:15-5:15 PM.

Power Hour: Power Hour is an opportunity for students to practice academic skills, catch up on homework, or get any extra support with their school day work. Power Hour will occur Mondays and Wednesdays from 4:50-5:20 PM.

Clubs: Each month we have a themed club. The goal of these clubs are to gain new skills, learn new information, and gain collaboration skills with their peers. We are so excited to run these clubs and hopefully spark a joy for new activities. These club activities will happen Tuesdays and Wednesdays from 4:50-5:20 PM. This month we will be learning how to play soccer! We will learn the basic skills needed to play a soccer game and enjoy our time with kind competition at the end of the month with our own soccer game.
