December Club & Activity Details

Message to Parents:

We're excited to welcome December at Bonneville with a month full of creativity, practical learning, and hands-on exploration! As we head into the winter season, students will continue growing their skills, confidence, and curiosity through a variety of engaging clubs and activities designed to keep their minds active and inspired.

Power Hour: Our sessions will continue as usual, providing dedicated time for homework help, reading, and academic enrichment. By collaborating closely with school-day teachers and supporting students in completing assignments on-site, we aim to reduce missing work and give families more meaningful time together at home. For students without homework, we offer a wide range of High Yield Learning Activities (HYLAs), as well as reading and math programs to help strengthen key academic skills. Students also have access to computers for iReady and other school-related curricula. Power Hour takes place Monday–Thursday for 60 minutes.

Practical Skills STEM Club: This month's featured clubs bring a blend of creativity and real-world learning to our program! In our **Practical Skills STEM Club**, youth will explore everyday problem-solving through hands-on projects and challenges. From simple building and design tasks to basic life-skills-inspired STEM activities, students will discover how science and creativity connect to daily life. Grades 4–6 will attend on Mondays and Wednesdays, while grades K–3 will participate on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

Creative Freedom Club: Our specialty club this month invites students to explore art in a fun, expressive, and open-ended way. Each session gives youth the chance to experiment with different materials, techniques, and artistic styles while building confidence and discovering their personal creative voice. This specialty club encourages imagination, self-expression, and joy through art. Students in grades K–3 will join on Mondays and Wednesdays, and grades 4–6 will participate on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

Social-emotional learning, we are beginning a new curriculum: **Positive Action**. This nationally recognized program helps youth build strong self-esteem, foster healthy relationships, and develop positive habits that support their overall well-being. Through engaging lessons, discussions, and activities, students learn how thoughts, feelings, and actions work together to shape their choices and success. Positive Action will take place during Friday rotations throughout the coming weeks.

We're looking forward to a month filled with growth, imagination, and discovery as we close out the year. Thank you for your continued support in making Bonneville Afterschool a place where kids can learn, express themselves, and thrive!



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
