### Message to Parents:

We love having your children in our afterschool program! To keep our environment positive, safe, and fun for everyone, we often remind our students of the Big 5 Expectations and wanted to give our parents/guardians a refresher:

- **Mutual Respect** – Treat others the way you want to be treated.
- **Active Attention** – Listen carefully and stay engaged during activities.
- **Participation** – Join in and give your best effort in all activities.
- **Respect the Classroom** – Keep our space clean, organized, and welcoming.
- **Respect at Afterschool** – Show kindness and follow rules while in the program.

These are the expectations we talk about whenever we need to gently redirect a student's behavior. If a student is having trouble following them, warnings and strikes may be given—this step is only used when necessary, and we try to prevent reaching that point whenever possible. It really helps if we work together to ensure every child has a safe, fun, and successful afterschool experience.

### Clubs & Activities:

**Lego Club** - is all about building, designing, and problem-solving with LEGO bricks! Students will work individually and in teams to create imaginative structures, explore engineering concepts, and have fun bringing their ideas to life.
