June Club & Activity Details

Message to Parents:

Welcome to the Timpanogos Summer Program with Boys and Girls Club. We are so excited for all the activities and clubs that we have planned for this summer and hope that our club members will have a summer to remember!

The club members will be separated into different age groups that they will be with for the summer program with opportunities to have some fun with the kids in other groups at recess, lunch, and other activities throughout the summer.

Every week each age group will participate in STEM and YES programs to keep their skills sharp over the summer. Our club members will also get to participate in a variety of clubs and activities in the morning and the afternoon, as shown below in the club descriptions, rotating through a different club each day.

Morning Clubs:

Little Scientists Lab - Little Scientists Lab sparks curiosity through hands-on experiments as kids explore, discover, and think like real scientists—ending with a fun Science Showcase of their favorite creations.

Soccer Club - Soccer Club builds skills, confidence, and teamwork through fun drills and scrimmages—enhanced by inspiring visits from real players and a positive, inclusive environment for all levels.

Mini Architects - Mini Architects empowers kids to design, build, and problem-solve through hands-on challenges—culminating in a creative City Showcase of their own imaginative structures.

Dance it Up - Dance It Up teaches kids to move, create, and perform with confidence—culminating in a fun summer showcase of their own dance routines.

Imagination Station - Imagination Station builds creativity and confidence through storytelling, roleplay, and themed adventures—ending with a fun showcase of students' imaginative performances.

Little Detectives - Little Detectives Camp turns kids into junior investigators, solving mysteries and completing challenges that build problem-solving, teamwork, and curiosity—all through hands-on, imaginative fun.

Young Entrepreneurs - Young Entrepreneurs Club lets kids turn ideas into action, learning business basics, teamwork, and creativity—culminating in a fun Market Day to showcase their creations.

Art Studio - Art Studio Club inspires creativity and confidence as students explore drawing, painting, and sculpture—culminating in an exhibition showcasing their original artwork.

Performance Lab - Performance Lab helps students build confidence and self-expression through acting and improv, culminating in a live showcase of their creativity and teamwork.



Mini Filmmakers - Mini Filmmakers Club lets kids bring stories to life through filming, editing, and teamwork—ending with a fun Film Premiere to showcase their creations.

CEO Kids (Entrepreneurship Club) - CEO Kids empowers young entrepreneurs to create, design, and market their own products—culminating in a hands-on Market Day to showcase their innovation and leadership.

Coding & Game Design - Coding & Game Design Club lets students create and code their own games, building problem-solving and tech skills—ending with a Game Showcase of their creations.

Content Creators Club - Content Creators Club lets students plan, film, and edit videos, building creativity and digital skills—culminating in a Creator Showcase of their work.

Leadership & Public Speaking - Leadership & Public Speaking Club helps students build confidence, communication, and teamwork—culminating in a Leadership Showcase to share their growth and ideas.

Afternoon Programming: Once lunch has been served, a bus will transport students enrolled in all-day care to the Provo Clubhouse, located at 131 N Olympic Blvd, Provo, UT 84606. There, students will participate in a traditional summer camp-style program filled with activities and enrichment opportunities.

Student pickup will be at 6:00 PM.

Our school-site summer program will end on **June 25th**. However, if your child is registered to continue with the Provo Clubhouse summer program, they may continue attending programming there through July.
