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## July Club & Activity Details

### Message to Parents:

The last two weeks we will have the most fun with fun water activities and celebrating 250 years of America's Independence Day! For America's 250th birthday club, we will do crafts, learn about the history, and even make safe "fire crackers".

### Morning Clubs:

Mini Mystery Science Club | Club lets students solve mysteries through hands-on experiments—building curiosity, critical thinking, and problem-solving, and ending with a fun parent challenge.

Yoga Club | Club helps students build focus, calm, and emotional awareness through relaxation and breathing techniques—ending with a guided meditation demonstration for parents.

Sports Exploration Club | Club lets students invent and play their own unique, high-energy games—developing coordination, creativity, teamwork, and problem-solving as they design rules and challenges and share their invented sports in a fun Mini Olympics for parents.

Sound & Light Exploration | Sound & Light Explorers Club lets students investigate sound waves, echoes, and light patterns—building curiosity, observation, and creativity, and ending with an interactive audio-visual showcase.

Leadership & Kindness Club | Leadership & Kindness Club helps students build teamwork, leadership, and empathy through community projects—culminating in a Kindness Showcase of their work and reflections.

Martial Arts Club | Martial Arts Club teaches students safe techniques while building focus, discipline, and confidence—culminating in a parent demonstration of their skills.

Fitness & Games Club | Club lets students build strength, coordination, and teamwork through obstacle courses and games—culminating in a live challenge course event for parents.

Puzzle & Brain Games | Brain Builders Club lets students solve puzzles, riddles, and logic games—developing problem-solving and critical thinking skills, and ending with a Puzzle Challenge Event.

Mini Inventors Club | Inventors Club lets students design and build creative inventions using everyday materials—developing problem-solving and engineering skills, and culminating in a parent Inventor Expo.

### Afternoon Programming:

3D Printing & Enrichment Club | Students will explore creative design and 3D pen techniques while participating in engaging enrichment activities—developing artistic skills, coordination, and innovative thinking for children from 3rd to 6th grade.

Art Around the World Club | Students explore different countries and cultures through art. Each session focuses on a new place around the world, helping students build global awareness and appreciation for diversity, and culminates in a World Showcase where students share what they've learned.



Advanced STEM Explorers | Students will engage in hands-on, challenge-based learning using professional "YES" kits and the comprehensive Engineering is Elementary (EIE) curriculum. This club focuses on building problem-solving, critical thinking, and technological literacy by diving into complex engineering challenges.

Positive Action Club | This program utilizes the Positive Action curriculum to focus deeply on the social-emotional learning of children, helping them build essential life skills, including self-management and social awareness.

Outdoor activities: this club offers high-energy fun with classic outdoor activities such as water days, active games, and jump roping, promoting fitness and teamwork.
