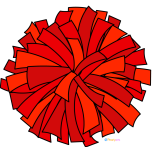

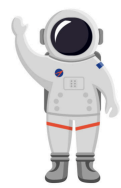


Group Voice

- **Kid Business** - Members will learn entrepreneurship basics including budgeting, marketing, teamwork, product creation, and running mini-business activities.
- **Anatomy Academy** - A hands-on science club where youth explore the human body, health, organs, and medical-themed experiments and activities.
