## July Club & Activity Details

### Message to Families:

Hello Families!

I am so excited to be running a summer program at Washington Elementary this summer! We are so excited to have our school year club kids, club kids from other schools and those of you who are new to club! The Summer Program for the Boys & Girls Club this year will be so packed with fun activities, special guests, our specialty classes, weekly themes and so much more! We hope to have a fun summer with all of the whimsical themes and events but also provide a great space for learning and fighting against the summer drop.

### Morning Specialty Classes :

#### **Gardening & Plant Life** -

Students will dig into the world of plants through hands-on gardening experiences. They'll learn how plants grow, how to care for them, and explore nature in a fun and interactive way. This class encourages responsibility, patience, and a love for the outdoors.

#### **Future Leaders** -

This meaningful class helps students build important everyday life skills while learning the value of helping others. Activities may include teamwork projects, simple service opportunities, problem-solving, and lessons in kindness, responsibility, and leadership.

#### **Fine Arts** -

Taught by a guest art teacher from Montessori, students will explore famous artists and recreate masterpieces using a variety of techniques and materials. This class encourages creativity, artistic expression, and appreciation for the visual arts.

#### **Math Through Animation & Claymation** -

Learning math has never been this fun! Students will explore math concepts through creative animation and claymation projects. By building, designing, and animating their own creations, they'll develop problem-solving skills while bringing their ideas to life.

#### **Start Up Studio** -

Start your own business and get creative! Students will brainstorm ideas, design and build their own inventions, and develop skills like teamwork, problem-solving, basic budgeting, and communication. In our maker space, they'll bring their ideas to life and practice sharing and improving their work. On June 26th they'll showcase and "sell" their creations at their own market booth!



## World Explorers -

Pack your (imaginary) bags! In this interactive class, students will explore different countries, cultures, traditions, and landmarks from around the world. Activities include crafts, games, and cultural experiences that broaden global awareness and curiosity.

### Afternoon Programming:

Students will get chances to work with other kids from different age groups and have some more voice and choice in the afternoon programming!

The afternoon is where we spend more time focused on our theme of the week in each of their activities whether its

- STEM
- Enrichment Club Based on the Theme
- Choice Time where they choose which activity they want to do presented from the teachers no matter which age group
- HYLA and WIN Time activities
- Positive Action
- “Terrific Thursdays they will either have a fun experience or special guest come which are:

For the themed weeks, students and teachers are encouraged to dress up to the theme if they would like for our “Terrific Thursdays”. Please stay away from play weapons, explicit shirts etc. Follow school dress code.

  - Animal Week: Favorite animal, dress up like your pet, zoo keeper, etc.
