Hello Families!

We're kicking off the year strong and soaking up those last days of summer fun! August is all about new friends, big energy, and exciting activities as we jump into a brand-new program year. Let's make it a great one!

STEM: We will be using the EIE (Engineering is Elementary) curriculum to design and construct strong bridges!

ENRICHMENT CLUB: In August, we're building our community in Community Club! We'll establish friendships, routines, expectations, and goals for the year—all while building a LEGO community together. Stop by during pick-up to see our progress!

CREATIVE CLUB: Creative Club is all about expression! Sometimes we will have a structured craft that teaches specific skills, other times we will provide open ended art activities where the youth get to decide what to create, how to express themselves, and more. We are excited to see what the youth come up with during this creative hour!

PHYSICAL CLUB: - We get physical activity every day, but on Fridays we have a club specific for games and sports to keep them active as well as health to learn how to take care of their own bodies.

DIGITAL CITIZENSHIP: Digital Citizenship is an empowering course for youth to learn how to be safe online. They will learn skills such as identifying suspicious behavior, information that should or should not be shared, and taking responsibility when they encounter something unsafe for youth online.

POSITIVE ACTION/ SMART MOVES: Positive Action and SMART Moves are fantastic programs we use to help the youth thrive with social skills! Through these lessons youth will be able to understand themselves and learn positive actions they can practice immediately to lead a happy, successful life ! This month we are focusing on establishing club agreements and setting the standard for respecting each other. We also will begin our unit about developing a positive self-concept.

PROJECT LEARN: Project Learn reinforces the academic enrichment & school engagement of youth while at club! This year we will all be using part of Project Learn time to strengthen our literacy skills through reading and literacy games Tuesday-Thursday afternoons.
