Welcome & FAQ

Message to Parents:

August is here, and we can't wait to kick off an incredible new school year! Our mission is to inspire youth to reach their fullest potential in a fun, safe, and supportive environment. We know that the best outcomes happen when we work together, and we are proud to partner with you as a team to help your children and youth thrive.

Astronauts Club:

Blast off into hands-on space exploration! In this interactive 3-part series, young space explorers will design and create their own custom astronaut puppet/character. This character becomes their personal guide for all future missions. Youth will participate in a hands-on solar system distance walk to learn about planetary scale and textures, and design a custom galaxy and planet for their astronaut to explore. Working in teams, youth will design, attach, and test stomp rockets using cardstock. After outside test launches, youth finalize and staple their completed Explorer's Journal to show off at home.

Frequently Asked Questions:

1. What is the Boys & Girls Club, and what makes your program special?

The Boys & Girls Club is a safe, positive place where kids can learn, play, and grow after school. We blend top-tier academic support with exciting enrichment activities to give your child a well-rounded, fun, and meaningful experience every single day.

2. What does a typical day look like for my child?

Every afternoon is packed with variety! Our structured daily schedule balances academic focus, creative projects, hands-on learning, and active play. A general afternoon includes homework support, engaging STEM activities, dynamic Enrichment Clubs, outdoor playtime, and structured social time with peers and mentors.

3. Do you provide snacks?

Yes! We know hungry kids can't focus or have fun, so we provide a nutritious power snack every day right when they arrive and a small snack before they go home. If your child has specific food allergies or dietary restrictions, just let our team know during registration so we can accommodate them.

4. Where and when does the program take place?

Our program operates Monday to Thursday, and it takes place right on campus at Red Mountain Elementary! As soon as the final bell rings at 3:30 pm, students walk directly to our designated Club space on school grounds—no travel or off-site transportation required. Pick up time is at 5:30 pm.

5. How do you partner with the school?

We maintain close communication about your child's progress with their teachers and administrators. We work directly with the school to align our program to what every child needs, and keep our doors open for feedback and input from our club members. To keep activities tailored, safe, and engaging, we divide our members into age-appropriate groups for our daily rotation stations.
