Photography Club - Photography Club gives students the opportunity to explore the world through a camera lens while learning the basics of composition, lighting, and storytelling. Members will participate in fun photo challenges and creative projects that build their artistic eye and technical skills. Throughout the term, students will create a collection of photos to showcase their creativity and growth.

Rollerblading Club - Rollerblading Club is a fun and active way for students to build confidence, coordination, and balance while learning new skating skills.
