Positive Action- The Positive Action curriculum is an evidence based program that is integrated in afterschool activities to build a positive environment throughout the program -- an environment that encourages students to do their best and be their best. Positive Action teaches real-life concepts that help students feel good about themselves.

Power Hour - The primary focus of Power Hour is to support our youth in completing their homework, engaging in High Yield Learning Activities (HYLAs), and participating in our reading and math programs. Our goal is to reduce missing assignments by collaborating with school-day teachers and ensuring that students complete their daily tasks during our program, allowing for more quality family time at home. For students without homework, we offer a variety of HYLAs, along with our reading and math programs, to further enhance their overall knowledge and skills in these important subjects.
