As we head into our second month of the school year, it has been wonderful to see our members building friendships, trying new activities, and growing in confidence each day. From creative projects and exciting clubs to active games and homework support, our afterschool program is in full swing and our staff loves watching students discover new talents and interests.

Thank you for your continued support and partnership. We encourage you to ask your child about their favorite club or activity each week—it's always fun to hear about the experiences they're having! We look forward to another month of learning, laughter, and making great memories together.

Pokémon Club - Pokémon club is a fun, social environment where students can build strategic thinking and math skills through the Pokémon Trading Card Game. Designed for middle schoolers of all skill levels, our club offers a safe space for members to play casual matches and make new friends.

Rollerblading Club - Rollerblading Club is a fun and active way for students to build confidence, coordination, and balance while learning new skating skills. Participants will practice safety, teamwork, and perseverance through games, drills, and group activities. Whether they are beginners or experienced skaters, everyone will have the chance to improve and have fun.

Dungeons and Dragons Club - D&D Club invites students into exciting fantasy adventures where they work together to solve problems, overcome challenges, and tell imaginative stories. Through collaborative gameplay, participants develop creativity, communication, critical thinking, and teamwork skills. No previous experience is needed—just a willingness to imagine and have fun.

Sculpting Club - Sculpting Club encourages students to express their creativity by transforming a variety of materials into three-dimensional works of art. Participants will learn different sculpting techniques while experimenting with clay, recycled materials, and other mediums. The club promotes patience, problem-solving, and artistic confidence through hands-on creation.

Art Around the World Club - Art Around the World introduces students to artistic styles, techniques, and traditions from cultures across the globe. Each week, participants will create projects inspired by artists and art forms from different countries while learning about their cultural significance. The club encourages creativity, appreciation for diversity, and self-expression through hands-on art experiences.

Sports Club - Sports Club gives students the opportunity to stay active while learning teamwork, sportsmanship, and healthy competition through a variety of games and activities. Participants will play different sports and recreational games that build coordination, communication, and leadership skills.
