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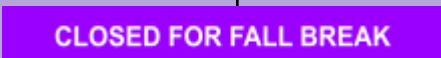
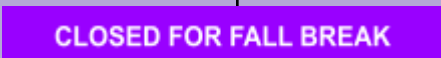

EIE STEM - This month we are wrapping up our unit on Maglev Systems like a mummy and beginning our unit on designing water filters! We're putting our engineering skills to the test! Students will design, build, and test their own water filters using different materials to see who can make the cleanest water. Lots of experimenting, problem-solving, and getting a little messy along the way!
